MEMBERSHIP

MEETINGS

CHARITY

In order for our club to qualify for continued approval from the Parrot Heads in Paradise National Chapter, AND for each member to qualify to purchase concert tickets allotted to each club (we pay full price but we get great seats!), every member is required to volunteer for charity events. Charity "points" are earned in a variety of ways, such as: Serving as a board member, attending meetings, volunteering to work at our Christmas in the Caribbean Christmas Party or Island Fever Party (our biggest fundraiser of the year), or any other charity event. Point values range from 50 by serving as a board member or working the Island Fever Party to 1 point for attending club meetings.

BUFFETT CONCERT TICKETS

Concert ticket availability will be based on the total number of points that could possibly be earned in that year. To be eligible, you must have earned 60% of the point value. Final ticket distribution will depend on the number of tickets assigned to our club. There's always the chance that as more chapters are formed, ticket numbers will be reduced.
